A MESSAGE ABOUT ORDINARY TIME

Beginning next week we move into a period in the church calendar called "ordinary time." Our journey from Lent to Pentecost is complete. In our time of worship we have sought to guide people in the way of Jesus (Lent), we have baptized them, and learned about preparation for the ministries they will undertake. On Pentecost, we’ve commissioned them into their ministry.

Our worship themes will mainly come from the Epistle readings. They will share wisdom regarding conflict (II Corinthians), stability and unity (Ephesians), faith (James), and the nature of Christ and the church (Hebrews).
