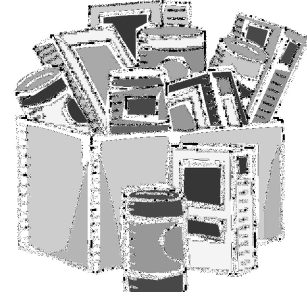


ANNOUNCEMENTS AND UPCOMING EVENTS

HARRY CHAPIN SENIOR FOOD BOX PROGRAM

Great news! We have partnered with Harry Chapin Food Bank, Edgewater UMC and Charlotte Harbor Trinity to make available monthly food boxes to those 60 years of age or older who live in Charlotte County. Once a month, the boxes will provide \$50-\$75 worth of assorted canned veggies, fruits, cereal, meats, and cheese to seniors.



ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

1. Must be at least 60 years old
2. Must be a resident of Charlotte County
3. Must show photo ID or immigration card
4. Monthly income limitations:
 - 1 person \$1,276
 - 2 people \$1,726
 - 3 people \$2,177
 - 4 people \$2,628
