Research shows the most valued services that caregivers of persons suffering from dementia can receive are education, supportive guidance, and care-giving tips. When armed with knowledge, caregivers 1) are better equipped to care for their loved one, 2) often experience significantly reduced stress levels, and 3) provide higher quality of care for their loved one and themselves.
