A significant percentage of the population has reactions to perfumes, colognes, and fragranced products that are worn by others. As scents become airborne, seemingly harmless fragrances can cause reactions for many. These reactions include headaches, nausea, and irritation of eyes, nose, throat, and skin. Many asthma attacks are triggered by fragrance as well.
