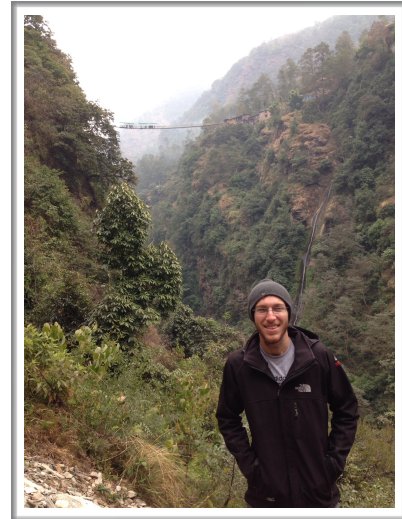




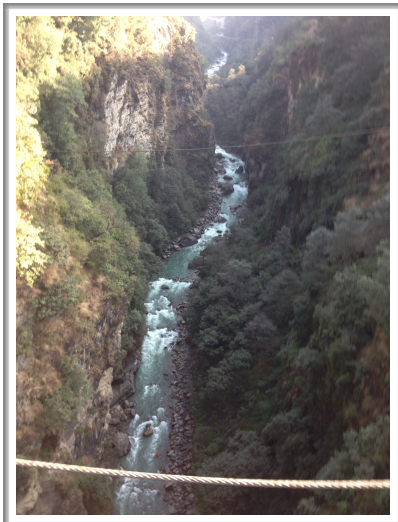
## January Newsletter
